STATE OF MAINE

In House of Representatives,

January 16, 1911.

Ordered, the Senate concurring, that the Committee on 2 Public Buildings and Grounds cause to be made an inventory 3 of the stock of fountain pens, scissors, nail files, penknives, 4 manicure sets, curling irons and other articles for the use of 5 statesmen, said to have been left over from the last admin-6 istration, and, after due notice to all concerned, dispose of 7 the same at public sale, and expend the proceeds for the 8 purchase of storm windows, mirrors, thermometers, brass 9 cuspidors and waste baskets, to replace the like articles 10 which are said to have mysteriously disappeared from the 11 committee rooms and other places in the State House at 12 about the time of final adjournment of the 74th Legislature.
