## STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, a Memorial to Congress for an Extra Session in Order that the Tariff may be Revised.

Resolved: Whereas it now appears that Congress will ad-

- 2 journ sine die March 4, 1911, without amending or repeal-
- 3 ing the Payne-Aldrich tariff law, and

Whereas the people of the United States, on Nov. 8, 1910,

- 5 by their votes repudiated the Payne-Aldrich high tariff law
- 6 in imposing unnecessary and burdensome taxation on the
- 7 necessaries of life of the American people, and

Whereas the Sixty-second Congress does not meet under

9 the Constitution until the first Monday in December, 1911;

Resolved, the Senate concurring, that the Legislature of

11 the State of Maine respectfully petitions the President of

12 the United States to exercise the power invested in him by

13 the Constitution of the United States to call immediately

14 an extraordinary session of Congress for the purpose of 15 revising or repealing the Payne-Aldrich high tariff law, and 16 to revise the tariff downward, thereby relieving the people 17 of the United States of the unjust burden of taxation im-18 posed on the necessaries of life by the Payne-Aldrich high 19 tariff law.

Resolved, That the President of the Senate and the Speaker 21 of the House of Representatives transmit a copy of this 22 resolution to the President of the United States, the Senate 23 of the United States, and the House of Representatives.
