IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the use of seines in John's Bay in the  
County of Lincoln.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

It shall be unlawful to use any purse or drag seines in John's  
2 Bay in the county of Lincoln from a line drawn easterly  
3 from the southeast point of High Island on the west side  
4 of John's Bay to a point opposite on the east side of said  
5 bay, excepting for taking smelts. Whoever violates the  
6 provisions of this act shall be subject to a fine of not less  
7 than twenty-five dollars nor more than fifty dollars.
