STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the use of seines in John's Bay in the County of Lincoln.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: It shall be unlawful to use any purse or drag seines in John's 2 Bay in the county of Lincoln from a line drawn easterly 3 from the southeast point of High Island on the west side 4 of John's Bay to a point opposite on the east side of said 5 bay, excepting for taking smelts. Whoever violates the 6 provisions of this act shall be subject to a fine of not less 7 than twenty-five dollars nor more than fifty dollars.
