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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE

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AN ACT to annex the Town of Stonington to the County of  
Knox.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. That the town of Stonington, in the county of  
2 Hancock, be and the same is hereby set off from said county  
3 of Hancock, and annexed to, and made part of, the county  
4 of Knox;

*Provided*, that all taxes upon said town or the inhabitants  
6 thereof, assessed by lawful authority, shall be paid, and the  
7 remedies for collecting the same shall remain as if this act  
8 had not been passed.
