STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend an Act entitled "An Act to authorize extensions of the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad in Aroostook, Piscataquis and Penobscot Counties." being Chapter 222 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, as amended by Chapter 70 of the Private and Special Laws of 1907.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All of the provisions of sections one, two, three

- 2 and four of chapter two hundred and twenty-two of the
- 3 Private and Special Laws of the year nineteen hundred and
- 4 three, as amended by chapter seventy of the Private and
- 5 Special Laws of the year nineteen hundred and seven, are
- 6 continued in force and extended for the period of five years
- 7 from and after the twentieth day of March in the year of
- 8 our Lord nineteen hundred and thirteen.
