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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

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AN ACT additional to and amendatory of chapter four hundred and twenty-four of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Kittery Water District within the limits of the town of Kittery for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants of said district, likewise the remaining portion of said town, with pure water for domestic and municipal purposes."

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The Kittery Water District is hereby authorized and empowered to extend its business into the town of York, from its present water main, over Cider Hill, so called, to Great Bridge, so called, and over Beach Ridge, so called, for the purposes of supplying the said town of York, within

6 this territory and the inhabitants thereof, with water for  
7 domestic and municipal purposes.

Sect. 2. Said Kittery Water District is hereby given and  
2 granted the same authority, rights and privileges to install,  
3 transact and carry on its business in said town of York  
4 within the territory above named as it has in the town of  
5 Kittery as set forth in its act of incorporation.
