STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred sixty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, as amended by chapter three hundred sixty-one of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and nine, relating to the Young Women's Christian Association of Portland, Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred sixty-nine
2 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and three,
3 as amended by chapter three hundred sixty-one of the pri-
4 vate and special laws of nineteen hundred and nine, is hereby
5 repealed and the following section substituted therefor, so
6 that said section one shall read as follows:

‘Section 1. The Young Women’s Christian Association of
8 the city of Portland, Maine, a corporation organized under
9 the laws of this state and located at said Portland in the
10 county of Cumberland is hereby authorized and empowered
11 to acquire by deed, devise, bequest or otherwise, and to hold
12 real and personal property to the amount of three hundred
13 thousand dollars.’

Sect. 2. The acts and doings of the meeting of said cor-
2 poration held on the twelfth day of May, in the year of our
3 Lord nineteen hundred and two, are hereby ratified, con-
4 firmed and declared to be legal and valid.
