STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to empower the County Commissioners of York
County to act under chapter one hundred and seventy-nine of
the Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, entitled "An Act
to provide a way to free toll bridges."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The county commissioners of York county are
2 hereby empowered and authorized to act under chapter one
3 hundred and seventy-nine of the public laws of nineteen
4 hundred and seven, entitled "An Act to provide a way to free
5 toll bridges," in making all toll bridges now or hereafter
6 located on the Piscataqua river, and its branches, between
7 the states of Maine and New Hampshire, free, when the
8 county commissioners of the counties of Rockingham and

9 Straford, or either of them, in the state of New Hampshire,
10 are empowered by the said state of New Hampshire to take
11 similar action.
