STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter one hundred fortysix of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, relating to the Commissioner of Public Works of City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section one of Chapter one hundred and forty-six of the Special and Private Laws of Eighteen hundred and ninety-five is hereby amended by striking out the word "second" in the second line and inserting in lieu thereof the word 'first' and by striking out the word "March" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof the word 'April' and by striking out in the third and fourth lines the words "Eighteen hundred

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and niney-five" and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'One thousand nine hundred and eleven,' and by striking out the word "three" in the seventh line and inserting in lieu thereof the word 'five', and by striking out the word "three" in the ninth line and inserting in lieu thereof the word 'five' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Portland is here-2 by authorized and empowered to appoint on the first Mon-3 day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine 4 hundred and eleven or as soon thereafter as may be sub-5 ject to the approval of the Board of Aldermen, a Commis-6 sioner of Public Works who shall be a Civil Engineer and 7 shall hold office for five years under this act, and until his 8 successor is qualified, each succeeding appointment there-9 after shall be for five years.

He shall receive such salary as the City Council shall de-11 termine. In case any vacancy shall occur, it may be filled 12 in the same manner for the unexpired term. He may be 13 removed by the Mayor for cause, subject to the Board 14 of Aldermen.

The Mayor of the City of Portland is hereby authorized 16 and empowered to appoint on the second Monday of March, 17 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and 18 ninety-five or as soon thereafter as may be, subject to the 19 approval of the Board of Aldermen, a competent person 20 to be designated as Secretary for the Commissioner of 21 Public Works and also for the Committee of Public Works

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22 named in section five of this act, who shall have charge 23 of all the records and books of registration of said Com-24 mittee, and of all the accounts of said Commissioner, who 25 shall hold office for two years at the first appointment un-26 der this act and until his successor is qualified, and there-27 after he shall be appointed to serve for the term of three 28 years and until his successor is qualified. In case any va-29 cancy should occur, the unexpired term shall be filled by 30 appointment in the same manner. He shall receive such 31 salary as the City Council shall determine.

He may be removed by the Mayor for cause, subject to 33 the Board of Aldermen. He shall perform such duties as 34 the Commissioner of Public Works may from time to time 35 determine.
