STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to set off a certain estate and the inhabitants thereof from the Norway Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The land and buildings owned by Freeland
2 Howe, Jr., situated at the summit of Pleasant Street Hill
3 in Norway together with the inhabitants thereon are here4 by set off from the Norway Village Corporation, and shall
5 no longer be entitled to the privileges granted, or be sub6 ject to the duties prescribed in the act creating said Cor7 poration.
