STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to revise and amend
the charter of the city of Calais."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-five of Chapter three hundred
2 and twenty-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen
3 hundred and eighty three, is being amended so as to read
4 as follows:

'Sect. 35. The judge of said court shall demand and
6 receive the same fees allowed to trial justices and clerk
7 of the supreme judicial court for similar services, except
8 that he shall receive for every blank writ signed by him,
9 four cents; for the entry of every civil action fifty cents;

10 for every warrant issued by him, one dollar; and for the
11 trial of an issue in civil or criminal cases, one dollar, and
12 two dollars for each day after the first occupied in such
13 cause, to be paid to him by the plaintiff in civil cases, be-
14 fore trial, who shall recover the same as costs if he pre-
15 vail in the suit. All fees, civil and criminal, shall enure
16 to the county of Washington and shall be paid over to the
17 treasurer of said county by said judge on the first day of
18 each month. The judge of said court shall receive an an-
19 nual salary of one thousand dollars and the recorder of
20 said court an annual salary of one hundred dollars in full
21 for all services, payable quarterly on the first days of April,
22 July, October and January, from the treasury of Washing-
23 ton County. All expenses of said court, including blank
24 books of record, docket and blanks necessary for the use
25 of said court, shall be paid from the treasury of the county
26 of Washington on vouchers approved by the county com-
27 missioners of said county, and said commissioners shall
28 audit and approve all accounts of said judge annually the
29 last of December for the previous year.
