STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the Compensation of the Clerk, Deputy and Assistant Clerks, of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. Paragraph 4 of Chapter 118 of the Public Laws 2 of 1905 is hereby changed so as to read as follows:

'Cumberland, twenty-seven hundred dollars, with sixteen 4 hundred dollars per year for additional clerk hire; assistant 5 clerk of courts, fifteen hundred dollars.'
