STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE. HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT relating to drains and common sewers in the City of Bangor.

Bc it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. Whenever the municipal officers of the city of
2 Bangor shall deem it necessary for public convenience or
3 health, that a public drain or sewer should be constructed in,
4 along or across any public way or through lands or persons
5 or corporations or in, along or across any way dedicated for
6 public uses, and shall order the same to be constructed and
7 paid for and from funds appropriated by the city for such
8 purposes, such further proceedings relative thereto shall be

9 had as are now, or may be hereafter provided, in the general10 laws of the state.

Sect. 2. The provisions of chapter 153 of the public laws 2 of the state for 1850, approved on the 14th day of June, 3 1850, at a meeting of the city council of said city of Bangor 4 specially called for the purpose; and chapter 717 of the pri-5 vate and special laws of the state for 1871, entitled "An Act 6 relating to drains and common sewers in the cities of Port-7 land and Bangor"; and chapter 242 of the private and special 8 laws for 1887, entitled "An Act to amend an Act relating to 9 drains and common sewers in the city of Bangor," and any 10 and all special laws or ordinances or by-laws relating to con-11 struction of drains and sewers, are, so far as relates to said 12 city of Bangor, hereby repealed and declared to be of no 13 force or effect.

Sect. 3. This act and repealing clause therein, shall not 2 apply to or affect any drain or common sewer constructed, 3 or assessment made, prior to the approval of this act.
