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AN ACT to amend Chapter 318 of the Private and Special  
Laws of 1909, relating to the hunting of deer in the town of  
Searsmont, in the county of Waldo.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. So much of chapter 318 of the private and  
2 special laws of 1909 as prohibits the hunting of deer in the  
3 town of Searsmont, in the county of Waldo, during the  
4 month of November of each year, under the same regulations  
5 that apply to that part of Waldo county where the hunting of  
6 deer is now permitted by law during the month of November  
7 of each year, is hereby repealed.
