STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 318 of the Private and Special Laws of 1909, relating to the hunting of deer in the town of Searsmont, in the county of Waldo.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. So much of chapter 318 of the private and
2 special laws of 1909 as prohibits the hunting of deer in the
3 town of Searsmont, in the county of Waldo, during the
4 month of November of each year, under the same regulations
5 that apply to that part of Waldo county where the hunting of
6 deer is now permitted by law during the month of November
7 of each year, is hereby repealed.
