IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 407 of the Private and Special
Laws of 1903, as amended, relating to fishing in Gull pond,
in Dallas Plantation, in the county of Franklin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of chapter 407 of the private and
2 special laws of 1903, as amended, as prohibits the taking,
3 catching or killing at any time any kind of fish in Gull pond,
4 in Dallas Plantation, in the county of Franklin, except in
5 the ordinary method of casting with artificial flies or fly fish-
6 ing, is hereby repealed, to take effect on June first, A. D.
7 1912.
