STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Little Lobster Lake, so called,
in the County of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time in Little Lob-
3 ster Lake, so called, situated in the county of Piscataquis,
4 for a period of two years from the time this act takes effect.

Sect. 2. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have
2 in possession any kind of fish at any time taken in violation
3 of the provisions of the first section of this act.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall
2 be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the general

3 law of the state for the illegal fishing for, taking, catching
4 and having in possession of trout or land-locked salmon.

Sect. 4. In all prosecutions arising under this act, munici-
2 pal and police courts and trial justices within their respective
3 counties shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent
4 jurisdiction with the supreme judicial and superior courts,
5 and all fines, forfeitures and penalties recovered by any per-
6 son for any violation of this act shall be paid forthwith by
7 the person receiving the same to the state treasurer.
