STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Sagamore Insurance
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Saga-
2 more Insurance Company, which were granted by chapter
3 87 of the private and special laws of one thousand nine hun-
4 dred and nine, are hereby extended for two years from the
5 approval of this act; and the persons named in said act, their
6 associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers
7 and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exer-
8 cised in the same manner and for the same purposes as speci-
9 fied in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
