STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE authorizing the Land Agent to release the State's interest in a certain ledge or reef, near Bar Harbor in Hancock County.

Resolved, That the State Land Agent be and he is hereby 2 authorized and empowered, upon payment of a nominal con3 sideration of five dollars (\$5.00) to make, execute and de4 liver a good and sufficient deed releasing to Rudolph E.
5 Brunnow of Princeton, Mercer county, state of New Jersey,
6 his heirs and assigns, all the right, title and interest which
7 the state of Maine has and which it has in any manner
8 acquired in and to a certain ledge or reef, situated in French9 man's Bay, near Bar Harbor in the town of Eden, Hancock
10 county, described as follows: A ledge or reef being at high
11 water about two hundred feet in length and containing above

12 ordinary high water mark about one-sixth of an acre, situ-13 ated near and directly in front of a lot of land owned by 14 said Rudolph E. Brunnow, together also with the shore con-15 nected with the same to low water mark.
