STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the construction and maintenance of a
bridge over flats and tide-waters in Back River in the town
of Boothbay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Willard O. Whitman, his heirs and assigns
2 are hereby authorized to construct and maintain a bridge
3 over flats and tide-waters in Back River in the town of
4 Boothbay, beginning midway of Tibbetts Island, so called,
5 and running easterly to land of Minerva Stover to intersect
6 with private way leading to Back River road.
