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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

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AN ACT to permit the plantation of Highland to assume the  
maintenance of its roads and bridges.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The plantation of Highland in Somerset county  
2 shall have the right, by accepting the provisions of this act,  
3 to assume the maintenance and repair of the ways and  
4 bridges within its borders by raising and expending money  
5 therefor, in which case it shall be subject to the provisions  
6 of section one hundred and eighteen of chapter four of the  
7 revised statutes and also those of section forty-one of chap-  
8 ter twenty-three of said revised statutes, as amended.

Sect. 2. Said plantation may accept the provisions hereof  
2 on or before the first day of November, in the year of our  
3 Lord nineteen hundred and twelve, in which case the clerk  
4 of said plantation shall immediately notify the clerk of the  
5 county commissioners of Somerset county of such action,  
6 who shall make a record of that fact, and thereupon said  
7 commissioners shall be relieved from all duties respecting  
8 the ways and bridges in that plantation from and after the  
9 first day of December following said action of said planta-  
10 tion.
