### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred twenty-three of the Public Laws of 1905, as amended by Chapter forty-three of the Public Laws of 1907.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. Chapter 123 of the Public Laws of 1905, as
2 amended by Chapter 43 of the Public Laws of 1907, is here3 by further amended by adding thereto the following sections:

Sect. 12. The Governor and Council may upon applica-5 tion, as provided in Section one, appoint a State agent for 6 the protection of children, who shall have the same powers 7 and duties as county agents, within each and every county 8 where there is no county agent, until a county agent is ap9 pointed and qualified therefor, or while a vacancy in the of-10 fice of county agent exists.'

'Sect. 13. Until the qualification of such State agent, any 12 agent for the protection of children appointed under the pro-13 visions of Section 1, may act in any county where no county 14 agent is appointed and qualified.'
