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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred twenty-three of the Public Laws of 1905, as amended by Chapter forty-three of the Public Laws of 1907.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter 123 of the Public Laws of 1905, as amended by Chapter 43 of the Public Laws of 1907, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following sections:

‘Sect. 12. The Governor and Council may upon application, as provided in Section one, appoint a State agent for the protection of children, who shall have the same powers and duties as county agents, within each and every county where there is no county agent, until a county agent is ap-

9 pointed and qualified therefor, or while a vacancy in the of-  
10 fice of county agent exists.'

'Sect. 13. Until the qualification of such State agent, any  
12 agent for the protection of children appointed under the pro-  
13 visions of Section 1, may act in any county where no county  
14 agent is appointed and qualified.'
