STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the Wiscasset, Waterville and Farmington Railway Company to dispose of a part of the property of said company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. The Wiscasset, Waterville and Farmington
2 Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon the oper-3 ation of all or of such part or parts, as the said company may
4 from time to time determine, of that part of its railroad ex-5 tending from the station at Weeks Mills to the station in
6 Winslow and to take up and remove and sell and convey as
7 personal property the rails, ties, switches and all other fix-8 tures including buildings, and to sell and convey all or any

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9 part of the real estate of said railroad belonging or apper-10 taining to the said part of its railroad.

Sect. 2. Said company is also authorized to sell and con-2 vey all of or such part or parts, as said company may from 3 time to time determine, of that part of its railroad extend-4 ing from the station at Weeks Mills to the station in Wins-5 low with and subject to the right for and in said purchaser 6 to abandon the operation of all or any part of said part of 7 said railroad and to take up and remove from said part or 8 from such part of said part as may be abandoned and to sell 9 and convey, as personal property, the rails, ties, switches and 10 all other fixtures including buildings and to sell and convey 11 all or any part of the real estate belonging or appertaining 12 to the said part of said railroad; and such purchaser shall 13 not be under any obligation to maintain and operate the said 14 part of said railroad and shall hold the same fully discharged 15 from any such obligation to operate and maintain.

Sect. 3. Said Company in case of and after any abandon-2 ment by it and said purchaser in case of and after any 3 abandonment by said purchaser shall prepare in duplicate a 4 certificate setting forth the fact of abandonment and what 5 part or parts of the said part of said railroad has been 6 abandoned and a general description thereof and file one of 7 the copies of said certificate in the office of the railroad com-8 missioners and one in the office of the secretary of state.

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
