RESOLVE, in favor of Louis Mitchel, Representative of Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.

Resolved: That the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars be and hereby is appropriated to pay Representative Louis Mitchel of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians, for his travel and attendance at this session of the Legislature.
