STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section fifty-six (56) of Chapter thirtytwo (32) of the Revised Statutes relating to the Disposal of money received for fines and penalies for violations of the fish and game laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section fifty-six (56) of Chapter thirty-two 2 (32) of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking 3 out all of said section after the word "same" in the eighth

4 line thereof, so that said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 56. Any officer or other person who shall receive 6 any fine or penalty, or any part thereof, for the violation of 7 any fish or game law, and shall neglect for more than thirty 8 days to pay the same into the state treasury, shall be pun-9 ished by a fine of not less than fifty, nor more than one hun-10 dred dollars; all fines and penalties recovered, or money 11 paid, under any of the provisions of this chapter, after de-12 ducting legal taxable costs, shall be paid forthwith to the 13 treasury of state by the person receiving the same.'
