Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of fifty dollars for services and forty-seven dollars for 3 mileage to be paid William R. Roix of Ashland for attend-4 ance as assistant clerk of the House of Representatives dur-

5 ing the organization of the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

William R. Roix was Assistant Clerk of the House of Representatives during the session of 1909; his home is at Ashland, Aroostook County, Maine. Ashland is situated on the Ashland Branch of the Bangor & Aroostook Railroad two hundred thirty-three miles from Augusta.

Mr. Roix left home for Augusta Monday, January 2nd, 1911, and was at work at the State House preparing the work of the Clerk and Assistant Clerk of the House of Representatives until Thursday night, January 5th, 1911, and left for home Friday morning, January 6th, expending five days of his time in travel and assistance in the organization of the House of Representatives of the Seventy-fifth Legislature.
