STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN' ACT to incorporate the Town of Stockholm.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section i. Township number sixteen, range three, west 2 from the east line of the State of Maine, in the County of 3 Aroostook, and known as Stockholm Plantation, is hereby 4 incorporated as a town under the name of Stockholm; and 5 the inhabitants thereof are hereby invested with all the pow-6 ers and privileges and subject to the duties and liabilities 7 incident to other towns in this state.

Sect. 2. The collectors of the Plantation of Stockholm 2 shall have power to finish the collection of all taxes which 3 have been committed to them for collection prior to the pass-4 age of this act, and to settle with and pay the same to the

5 treasurer of the town of Stockholm; and the several officers 6 of said plantation are empowered to perform all the duties 7 of town officers in the town created by this act, until their 8 successors shall have been chosen and qualified as town offi-9 cers of the town of Stockholm under this act.

Sect. 3. Any justice of the peace may call the first meet-2 ing of the town of Stockholm by posting a warrant therefor, 3 stating the object of said meeting, in three public and con-4 spicuous places in said town, at least seven days before the 5 time of holding said meeting.

Sect. 4. All property now belonging to Stockholm Plan-2 tation shall belong to, and the title thereof is hereby vested 3 in the town of Stockholm.

Sect. 5. The persons hereafter becoming chargeable as 2 paupers within the limits of said town shall be chargeable 3 to said town of Stockholm, excepting those who are now 4 State paupers.
