STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HÜNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 4 of Chapter one hundred and thirty-three of the Public Laws of 1909, relating to contagious diseases among cattle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 4 of Chapter one hundred and thirty2 three of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking
3 out the word "agent" in the sixth line and inserting in place
4 thereof the word 'veterinary,' so that said section as amend5 ed shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. Whenever it has been determined that an an-7 imal is diseased with tuberculosis and when it shall have 8 been condemned and slaughtered under the direction of the 9 cattle commissioners, their said commissioners shall thor10 oughly and effectively disinfect the stable where such animal
11 has been kept or cause the same to be done by a competent
12 veterinary in the employ of said commissioners, and the ex13 pense incurred on account of said disinfection shall be paid
14 for out of the appropriation allowed for the use of the cattle
15 commissioners.'
