STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of E. F. Coburn of Andover, Maine.

Resolved: That the sum of sixty dollars be and is hereby 2 appropriated to be paid to E. F. Coburn of Andover, Maine, 3 to reimburse him for money paid out to complete the work 4 of placing and re-setting buoys on Upper and Lower Rich-5 ardson Lakes for which an appropriation was made by the 6 last legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The legislature of 1909 made an appropriation of two hundred and fifty dollars to be expended under the direction of the state steamboat inspectors in placing buoys at such points in Richardson lake as would best serve the needs of navigation thereon.

Through error this appropriation was made only for the year 1909 when it should have been available in 1910 also. The work was not completed in 1909—but \$150 of the appropriation having been expended during that year—and in order to complete the work Mr. Coburn paid out \$50 for placing five buoys and \$10 for re-setting five of the buoys which were pulled out of place by logs.

This resolve, consequently, is to reimburse Mr. Coburn for the amount he has expended in this connection.

It will be noticed that \$40 of the appropriation was not used in this work.
