STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to grant additional powers to the Lubec Sardine
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Lubec Sardine Company, a corporation or-
2 ganized under the general laws of Maine and located at
3 Lubec, is hereby authorized to generate, sell, distribute and
4 supply electricity for power, heating, lighting, manufactur-
5 ing and mechanical purposes in the town of Lubec.

Sect. 2. Said Lubec Sardine Company is hereby empow-
2 ered to set poles and extend wires and lay pipes and con-
3 duits and construct and maintain its lines in, upon, along,
4 over, across and under the streets and roads in said town of
5 Lubec, for the purpose of furnishing electric light and power.

6 for heating, manufacturing and mechanical purposes for
7 public and private use in said town under such reasonable
8 restrictions as may be imposed by the municipal officers of
9 said town, subject to the general law of the state regulating
10 the erection of poles and lines and laying pipes and con-
11 duits for the purposes of electricity.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
