STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 233 of the Private and Special Laws of 1909, entitled "An act for the protection of Deer in York County."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Section I of said Chapter is hereby amended
2 by adding the following: 'Provided, however, that it shall
3 be unlawful to hunt, chase, catch or kill any deer within
4 the limits of the Town of York, in said County, at any
5 time,' so that when amended said section shall read as fol6 lows:

'Section 1. There shall be an annual close time for deer, 8 during which it shall be unlawful to hunt, take, catch, kill 9 or destroy any deer, in the county of York, from December 10 first to October thirty-first, inclusive, following of each

11 year. It shall be unlawful to hunt, chase, catch or kill 12 more than one deer in said county during the month of 13 November in each year, and it shall be unlawful to have 14 in possession in one open season more than one deer which 15 has been killed in said county. It shall be unlawful to hunt 16 deer with a shot gun in this county. Provided, however, 17 that it shall be unlawful to hunt, chase, catch or kill any deer 18 within the limits of the Town of York, in said County, at 19 any time.'
