STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate the hunting of deer in Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 1. There shall be an annual close time for deer,
2 during which it shall be unlawful to hunt, take, catch, kill
3 or destroy any deer, in the county of Waldo, from the fif-
4 teenth day of December of each year to the fifteenth day
5 of November of the following year, inclusive. It shall be
6 unlawful to hunt, chase, catch or kill more than one deer
7 in said county in one open season, and it shall also be un-
8 lawful to have in possession in one open season more than
9 one deer, or part thereof, which has been killed in said
10 county.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall

2 be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the general
3 law of the state for illegal hunting, chasing, killing or hav-
4 ing in possession of deer.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and
2 police courts and trial justices within their respective coun-
3 ties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent
4 jurisdiction with the supreme judicial and superior courts,
5 and all fines, forfeitures and penalties received for viola-
6 tion of this act shall be paid forthwith by the person re-
7 ceiving the same to the state treasurer.

Sect. 4. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act
2 are hereby repealed.
