STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit trout fishing in Alder brook, so-called,
in the towns of Island Falls and Hersey, and in Dyer brook,
so-called, in the towns of Island Falls and Dyer brook, and
in Merrill Plantation, in Aroostook county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch
2 or kill any trout at any time in Alder brook, so-called, in
3 the towns of Island Falls and Hersey, in the county of
4 Aroostook, or in Dyer brook, so-called, in the towns of Is-
5 land Falls and Dyer brook and in Merrill Plantation, in
6 said county of Aroostook, for a period of four years from
7 the time this act takes effect. It shall also be unlawful

8 for any person to have in possession any trout taken in vio-
9 lation of this section.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall
2 be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the gen-
3 eral law of the state for the illegal fishing for, or taking,
4 catching, killing or having in possession of trout or land-
5 locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, munici-
2 pal and police courts and trial justices within their re-
3 spective counties shall have, upon complaint, original and
4 concurrent jurisdiction with the supreme judicial and su-
5 perior courts, and all fines, forfeitures and penalties re-
6 covered by any person for any violation of this act shall
7 be paid forthwith by the person receiving the same to the
8 state treasurer.
