STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section twelve of Chapter one hundred and twelve of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seven as amended by Chapter sixty-nine of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and nine relating to the appropriation for State Highways.

WHEREAS, the appropriation for the permanent im2 provement of main highways or state roads should be
3 available at an early date, and the statute providing for
4 the raising of funds for this purpose should be amended;
5 therefore, in the judgment of the Legislature, the measure
6 hercin proposed is immedately necessary for the preserva7 tion of the public peace, health or safety.

12 follows:

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section twelve (12) of Chapter one hundred

and twelve (112) of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred

and seven as amended by Chapter sixty-nine of the Public

Laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby amended by

striking out the words "there shall be assessed annually

on all property in this state a tax of three-fourths of one

mill on each dollar of valuation" and inserting in place

thereof the following: 'there shall be appropriated out of

any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated,

the sum of two hundred and fifty thousand (250,000) dol
lars annually' so that said section as amended shall read as

'Section 12. To provide funds for the purposes of this 14 act there shall be appropriated out of any funds in the 15 state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of two 16 hundred and fifty thousand (250,000) dollars annually for 17 the exclusive use and purposes set forth in this act. Any 18 unexpended balance at the end of any year shall be added 19 to the fund for the next year. From this fund shall be paid 20 all state aid for road improvement as provided for under 21 this act.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
