STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate ice fishing in Lake Wassokeag, so-called,
in the town of Dexter, in the county of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish on or through the ice in Lake Wasso-
3 keag, so-called, in the town of Dexter, in the county of Pe-
4 nobscot, except on Wednesday and Saturday of each week
5 said pond is closed by ice, on which days it shall be lawful
6 to fish through the ice in said pond in accordance with the
7 general law of the state. Provided, however, it shall be
8 unlawful for any person to take, catch or kill in any one day
9 while fishing through the ice in said lake more than ten

10 pounds of fish in all. It shall also be unlawful for any per-
11 son to have in possession any kind of fish taken in violation
12 of any provision of this section.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall
2 be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the general
3 law of the state for the illegal fishing for or taking, catch-
4 ing or killing of trout or land-locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, muni-
2 cipal and police courts and trial justices within their respec-
3 tive counties shall have, upon complaint, original and con-
4 current jurisdiction with the supreme judicial and superior
5 courts, and all fines, forfeitures and penalties recovered by
6 any person for any violation of this act shall be paid forth-
7 with by the person receiving the same to the state treasurer.
