STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to facilitate the identification of criminals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Prisoners who have been convicted of a felony

- 2 and committed under sentence may, if deemed advisable, for
- 3 the purpose of subsequent identification be measured and
- 4 described in accordance with the Bertillon method for the
- 5 identification of criminals, and their photographs and finger
- 6 prints taken.
- Sect. 2. Chapter one hundred and seventy-five of the Pub-
- 2 lie Laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby repealed.
