STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Mutual Fire Ins. Co.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. The rights, powers and privileges of the Mutual 2 Fire Insurance Company which were granted by chapter 3 five hundred and thirty-four of the private and special laws 4 for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and ex-5 tended by chapter seventy-one of the private and special 6 laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine and again ex-7 tended by chapter two hundred and ninety of the private 8 and special laws of nineteen hundred and one, and again 9 extended by chapter ninety-two of the private and special 10 laws of nineteen hundred and three and again extended by 11 chapter three hundred and nineteen of the private and special

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12 laws of nineteen hundred and five, and again extended by 13 chapter one hundred and eleven of the private and special 14 laws of nineteen hundred and seven and again extended by 15 chapter sixty-one of the private and special laws of nineteen 16 hundred and nine, are hereby further extended for two years 17 from the going into effect of this act, and the persons named 18 in said act, their associates and successors, shall have the 19 rights, powers and privileges that were granted to them by 20 said act to be exercised by them for the same purposes as 21 specified in said act.

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
