STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to build and repair a dyke in the town of Milbridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Joel G. Gay, Jasper Wyman, Edgar M. Gay,
2 William M. Blood, their associates, successors and assigns,
3 are hereby authorized to build and maintain a good and
4 sufficient dyke, at Back Bay in the town of Milbridge, to
5 commence at a point on the west side of Grain point, so
6 called, and to extend over tide waters across the creek there
7 situated to land of Alonzo Fickett in shore of the site of the
8 old dyke formerly built across said creek by the grantors of
9 said Gay and others and to repair and maintain said old dyke.
