STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to build and repair a dyke in the town of Milbridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Joel G. Gay, Jasper Wyman, Edgar M. Gay,

William M. Blood, their associates, successors and assigns,

are hereby authorized to build and maintain a good and

sufficient dyke, at Back Bay in the town of Milbridge, to

commence at a point on the west side of Grain point, so

called, and to extend over tide waters across the creek there

situated to land of Alonzo Fickett in shore of the site of the

old dyke formerly built across said creek by the grantors of

said Gay and others and to repair and maintain said old dyke.
