STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the town of York to construct a way
across tidewater of Barrell's Mill Pond, so called, in York
Harbor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The inhabitants of the town of York are hereby
2 authorized to construct and maintain a public pedestrian
3 promenade across a bay of tidewater in York Harbor locally
4 known as Barrell's Mill Pond, the same to be constructed
5 over and along the dam of said Mill Pond.
