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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

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AN ACT to extend the charter of the Fire Insurance Company  
of Portland, Maine.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Fire  
2 Insurance Company of Portland, Maine, which were granted  
3 by chapter four hundred and seven of the private and special  
4 laws of the State of Maine for the year nineteen hundred  
5 nine are hereby extended for two years additional, and the  
6 persons named in said act, their associates and successors,  
7 shall have the rights, powers and privileges that were granted  
8 to them by said act to be exercised by them for the same  
9 purposes as specified in said act.
