STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 15 of Chapter 132 of the Revised
Statutes relating to limitation of prosecutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 15 of Chapter 133 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word "man-
3 slaughter" in the second line thereof, the words 'or em-
4 bezzlement or fraudulent conversion of the bullion, money,
5 notes, bank notes, checks, drafts, bills of exchange, obliga-
6 tions or other securities for money, of any savings bank
7 incorporated under the laws of this state, by any officer of
8 such savings bank,' so that said section as amended shall
9 read as follows:

'Sect. 15. When no other limitation is provided, no indict-

11 ment for any offense, except treason, murder, arson or man-
12 slaughter, or embezzlement or fraudulent conversion of the
13 bullion, money, notes, bank notes, checks, drafts, bills of
14 exchange, obligations or other securities for money, of any
15 savings bank incorporated under the laws of this state, by
16 any officer of such savings bank, shall be found after six
17 years from the commission thereof; but any time, during
18 which the offender is not usually and publicly resident in the
19 state, shall not be a part of such six years.'
