### STATE OF MAINE

#### RESOLVE, In Favor of Arlington J. Day.

*Resolved*: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of (\$35.10) thirty-five dollars and ten cents in favor 3 of Arlington J. Day of Wesley, Maine, to reimburse him for 4 a balance due on a bill of supplies furnished to fire warden 5 service in fighting fires on townships twenty-four, twenty-6 five, thirty, and thirty-one, during summer of one thousand 7 nine hundred and eight.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

During the summer of 1908 fires raged on townships 24, 25, 30 and 31 in Washington County.

Arlington J. Day, of Wesley, furnished a bill of goods to Victor M. Smith, chief forest fire warden, amounting to \$149.48.

On the same bill Mr. Day received check from E. E. Ring for \$114.38, leaving a balance due to Mr. Day of \$35.10 which he has been unable to collect.
