STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 243 of the Public Laws of 1909
relating to the election of assessors in towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 243 of the Public Laws of 1909 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the words "of Six Thou-
3 sand inhabitants or more" in the first line thereof, and in-
4 serting in its stead the words 'whose boards of assessors
5 or selectmen consist of not more than three members each,'
6 and by adding after the word "assessors" in the second
7 line, the words 'and selectmen' so that said Section, when
8 amended shall read as follows:

'Any town whose boards of assessors or selectmen con-
10 sist of not more than three members each may provide by

11 its by-laws for the election of a board of assessors and
12 selectmen to serve for the term of three years, one mem-
13 ber of such board being elected annually in the manner now
14 prescribed for the election of members of the superintending
15 school committee in towns.'
