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AN ACT to annex Fryeburg Academy Grant to the Town of  
Mason.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Fryeburg Academy Grant, an unorganized  
2 township in the county of Oxford, is hereby annexed to  
3 and made a part of the town of Mason in said county.

Sect. 2. The several inhabitants of said Fryeburg Acad-  
2 emy Grant and the several non-resident owners of real es-  
3 tate in said Grant shall be holden to pay all taxes legally  
4 assessed upon the property in said Grant by the State  
5 Board of Assessors pending the taking effect of this act,  
6 to the inhabitants of said Mason; and the collector of  
7 taxes of said town of Mason is hereby authorized and

8 required to collect all taxes so assessed upon the property  
9 in said Grant, a list of which taxes shall be submitted to  
10 him by said board of assessors.

Sect. 3. All expenses for schools and roads in said Grant,  
2 subsequent to the passage of this act and pending its tak-  
3 ing effect, heretofore assumed and borne by the State, shall  
4 be paid by said town of Mason out of the moneys accru-  
5 ing to said town from said assessment by said State board  
6 of assessors.
