RESOLVE, in favor of O. M. Davis, of Hersey, Aroostook  
County, Maine.

*Resolved:* That the sum of twenty dollars be and is here-  
2 by appropriated to be paid to O. M. Davis, of Hersey, Aroos-  
3 took County, Maine, to reimburse him for damage done his  
4 property by beaver during the year 1910.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mr. Davis sustained a large amount of damage to his crops—having only half a hay crop—by reason of his field being flooded by beaver, and as the law would not permit the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game to pay for damage done by beaver, this special resolve is introduced to reimburse him to some extent for the damage. This is the amount agreed upon by Mr. Davis, after a conference with the game warden sent by said Commissioners to investigate this complaint.
