IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to protect striped or sea bass, in the waters of the  
Sheepscot River and its tributaries.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for or catch striped  
2 or sea bass in the waters of the Sheepscot River and its at-  
3 tributaries except by hook and line.

Sect. 2. Any person convicted of fishing or catching  
2 striped or sea bass in any other way except by hook and  
3 line shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars  
4 nor more than twenty-five dollars, by complaint or indict-  
5 ment. One-half to the use of the complainant and one-half  
6 to the county. Full jurisdiction to impose such fine is here-  
7 by conferred upon trial justices.
