STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section thirty-four, Chapter four, of the
Revised Statutes, 1903, of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-four of Chapter four of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
3 words "registered voters of such city" in the second and
4 third lines of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the
5 words 'votes cast,' so that said section, as amended, shall
6 read as follows:

'Sect. 34. No change made by the City Council, in the
8 limits of any city ward, shall be valid unless it is approved
9 by a majority of the legal votes cast at the election of city

10 officers held next after such action of said council; and
11 warrants for such ward meetings shall contain an article for
12 that purpose.'
